When will it happen?

The NSO Workshop Marketplace will take place on 21 August 2024 and will comprise of two sessions:

- The **first session** runs from 09:30-10:30.
- The **second session**, from 11:00-12:30, will continue the showcase.

What do you need to know?

Some things to keep in mind to ensure that every workshop is engaging and meaningful for everyone at the conference...

- Please ensure that young people are involved in the planning, preparing, and delivering of your workshop. We ask that at least one of your lead facilitators is under 30 years old if possible.
- If you plan to conduct your workshop in another language than English, please mark this clearly in the form so we can explore, within the limits of your NSO as well as WOSM's interpretation and translation resources, how we can support you in making the workshop accessible to as many participants as possible.
- We are looking especially for NSOs that have worked with WOSM on joint projects or initiatives over the last Triennium
- Workshops will accommodate an average of 50 to 80 participants per session.
- Guidance and support for workshop facilitators will be sent out after all workshops have been confirmed.
- Applications for workshops must be endorsed by the submitting NSO
